New resource for school preparation and response planning

Western Australia's low numbers of COVID-19 are encouraging, however we cannot be complacent and need to ensure that schools are prepared to respond should we have further COVID-19 outbreaks.

End of school year events

Support in planning COVID-19 safe end of school year events, such as graduation and valedictory events is available. At this time, Western Australia is due to progress to Phase 5 on 24 October 2020, however schools should ensure contingency planning related to events should Phase 4 continue.

On Monday 22 June, the WA Premier released a media statement to announce details of the remaining phases of Western Australia's Roadmap for easing restrictions.

Follow COVID-19 specific considerations to assist you to plan your next face-to-face event:

- Inform parents in writing of COVID-safe requirements. For example, physical distancing, good health and hygiene.
- Advise parents of any potential consequences of a cancellation of the event.
- Make hand sanitiser available to all participants.
- Control entry and exit to rooms and the venue to maintain physical distancing.
- Minimise communal sharing of resources and equipment.
- Enhance the cleaning of the venue, particularly high touch areas.
- Control entry and exits to the toilets.
- Encourage your participants to:
 - not attend events if they are unwell
 - follow good hygiene practices such as hand washing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
 - avoid sharing common items such as cutlery and crockery.
