



| <p>BEST EVER NO-COOK PLAY DOUGH RECIPE</p> <p>Ingredients:</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-between;"> <div style="width: 45%;"> <p>2 cups plain flour 1/2 cup salt food colouring (optional) few drops glycerine (my secret ingredient for stretch and shine!)</p> </div> <div style="width: 45%;"> <p>2 tablespoons vegetable oil (baby oil and coconut oil work too) 2 tablespoons cream of tartar 1.5 to 2 cups boiling water (adding in increments until it feels right)</p> </div> </div> <p>Method</p> <p>Mix the flour, salt, cream of tartar and oil in a large mixing bowl. Add food colouring to the boiling water then into the dry ingredients. Stir continuously until it becomes a sticky, combined dough. Add the glycerine (optional). Allow it to cool down then take it out of the bowl and knead it vigorously for a couple of minutes until all of the stickiness has gone. * This is the most important part of the process, so keep at it until it's the perfect consistency! * If it remains a little sticky then add a touch more flour until just right</p> | | | | | | <p>1</p> <p>Think of a number from 1- 5 and have your family guess it.
