# **2024 CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES**



**Dear Parents and Carers** 

The Lathlain Primary School Board has endorsed our schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2024 in accordance with the School Education Regulations 2000 as part of the School Education Act 1999. This schedule is designed to provide you with information about anticipated costs that may occur throughout the coming school year.

### 1. Contributions

Contributions for students from Kindergarten to Year 6 in 2024 will be **\$60.00 per child** and are considered pertinent when supplementing the funding of curriculum areas. While contributions are voluntary, the quality of our learning programs are maximised when all families contribute, as can be appreciated in the examples below:

- English- ensuring ongoing reading book availability
- Mathematics- investing in quality resources and supplementary materials
- Science- replacing consumable materials for experiments
- Mumanities and Social Sciences- developing current resource materials
- \* The Arts- replenishing consumable materials, e.g.- paint, card, clay
- Physical Education- investing in accessible resources
- Library- supplementing book acquisition
- Photocopying- maintaining adequate resources

At Lathlain Primary School, we have an active P&C who play an important role in the life of the school. The P&C contributions support students, providing resourcing to enhance the educational activities of the school and helps build community within the school by organising events which bring parents, citizens, staff and students together. The P&C operates the canteen, fundraises and coordinates events. In 2024, funds are also raised through the *P&C Voluntary Contribution*, which is **\$30 per child or \$70 for three or more children**.

Payments for school contributions can be made through your child's 2024 *Personal Items Requirements List* or directly to the school.

### 2. Charges

Charges vary across year levels depending on the nature and range of activities undertaken. The *Schedule of Maximum Charges* overleaf represents the estimated **maximum amount** that a parent/carer should anticipate being charged throughout the school year. Very few students, if any, participate in the full range of activities available.

The Schedule of Maximum Charges includes costs associated with:

- Specific learning activities that are available to <u>all students</u> but conditional on a payment being made e.g. excursions/incursions, Edu Dance
- Specific learning activities that are available to <u>selected students</u>, but conditional on payment being made e.g. IMSS (instrumental music), PEAC, choir etc
- Other activities that are available to <u>some students</u> but conditional on a payment being made e.g. Year 6 Camp and Graduation

The school Finance Policy has been endorsed by the School Board and is available on the school website and from school office. Refunds or transfer of charges and voluntary contributions will occur in accordance with the Department of Education's Contributions, Charges and Fees Manual. If a student does not participate in an excursion or incursion the school cannot guarantee a full refund where external provider costs have been agreed or prepaid.

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## **Schedule of Maximum Charges**

A breakdown of the estimated **maximum amount** that a parent/carer should anticipate being charged for their child's participation in excursions, incursions and other school based activities for 2024 has been included.



Please **do not** pay these charges in advance, the exact charge is calculated closer to the dates of the individual events. Parents /carers are invoiced once this is calculated.
