Payment of 2024 Fees and Charges:

Thank you to those parents who have made payment of Fees and Charges via Campion stationery orders. The office is now ready to receive 2024 payments.

Statements will be sent home soon and will include the school BSB & account details for direct deposit. Payment can also be made by EFTPOS or cash in the school office.

Please do not pay contributions if you have already made payment through Campion.

When making direct deposits, it is essential that the student's surname and first initial are included in the comment. Where possible please also list the items you are paying.

Update your contact information:

Student update forms will be sent home in the next few weeks. Please check the information carefully and make any necessary changes, or alternatively, tick the box indicating no changes are needed.

It is imperative contact details are kept up to date as this information is used should the school need to call you in an emergency situation or if your child is unwell. The school requires at least three to four emergency contacts.

Gate Closure Times:

Children who arrive at school prior to 8.40 am are expected to sit on the benches or verandah outside their class-room until classroom doors open. There is limited supervision available prior to this time. Students are not permitted to play on equipment or run around the quadrangle. Please do not drop children at school before 8:15am.

All students who arrive after 8:50am are required to be signed in and need to collect a late pass from the office.

The school gates are locked from 8.50am -2.45pm. During these times, parents are asked to enter the school via the front office. All visitors are required to sign in as a visitor using the iPad. When collecting your child early, please sign your child out and give the class teacher the sign out pass.

End of the school day:

All Pre-primary to Year 6 students are to be collected at 3pm, Kindy students are collected at 3:10pm. Pre-primary to Year 6 students who are not collected at 3pm will be taken to the office and parents will be called.

TheirCare and Cuddles offer before and after school care for parents who cannot make the 3pm collection.
