Gate Closure Times:

Children who arrive at school prior to 8.40 am are expected to sit on the benches or verandah outside their classroom until classroom doors open. There is limited supervision available prior to this time. Students are not permitted to play on equipment or run around the quadrangle. Please do not drop children at school before 8:15am.

All students who arrive after 8:50am are required to be signed in and need to collect a late pass from the office.

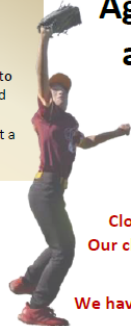
